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"Intimacy is perhaps the best film to watch if you're looking for a quiet, well-paced, well-acted drama. The story centers on a middle-aged doctor (James Stewart), who is contacted by the wife of a patient (Debra Winger) who is confined to a hospital. In quick, convincing scenes, the doctor develops a love affair with the woman, one made all the more poignant by the fact that she's dying of a fatal disease. The story is understated but all the more powerful for it. The acting is superb throughout, particularly that of Stewart, who brings a tender, steady heart to his role.
