















Old West Country Sightseeing



Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum near Tucson pays careful tribute to the wildest of the desert, and displays a wide range of animals and plants found in the entire Sonoran Desert. Abutting the museum is Saguaro National Park, which contains some of the finest specimens of towering saguaro cacti found anywhere in the world.

On the outskirts of Tucson in the foothills of the Santa Catalina

Mountains, Sabino Canyon is a must-visit. Tram rides are available in the lower stretches of the canyon, and hiking trails lead to a series of waterfalls and pools along a beautiful stream and large areas of pristine desert habitat.

The rock formations found at Chiricahua National Monument are striking towers of stone that seem like a forest of rock sculptures. The warrior chief Cochise and his Apache followers roamed this territory years ago. It's been said that when Cochise died he was buried in Stronghold Canyon where his followers ran their horses up and down the canyon trails to erase all traces of the grave.
