

Colourful start to film festival

Thiruvananthapuram, Dec 10 The sixth International Film Festival of Kerala, IFFK 2004, got off to a colourful start here on Friday evening.

Chief Minister Oommen Chandy inaugurated the festival by lighting the traditional lamp at the Nagoorudi Open Air Auditorium. Noid Film-maker Shyam Bheegal, IFFK jury chairman and Mexican film-maker Paul Leder and veteran film-maker P.N.Mohan, were among the dignitaries who were present on the dais on the occasion. Cultural Affairs Minister A.P.Jacob presided over the function.

The inaugural ceremony followed a 45-minute cultural show.

In his inaugural speech, the Chief Minister said that the Government would continue to support the film industry in the State. Expressing his hope that the IFFK would act as a catalyst for the growth of the good film culture in the State, Chandy said that the Government had deci-

Boycott by Left parties

Thiruvananthapuram, Dec 10 The Left parties on Friday boycotted the inaugural ceremony of the IFFK 2004. As part of this, Mayor J.Chandran also did not turn up for the event.

The only anti-Congress political leader who was present at the inaugural ceremony was BJP State general secretary P.P.Mukundan. Chandran's refusal to appear was said to keep all the factions in protest against the UDF Government's attitude to certain issues.

The office-bearers of the Association of Malayalam Movie Artists (AMMA) were also conspicuous by their absence from the inaugural ceremony. The Malayalam Cine Technicians' Association (MCTCA) also did not show. The inaugural function itself was conceived and staged by K. Hanuman. The AMMA office-bearers clarified that their absence was purely owing to time constraints.
